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## BRIEF PRESENTATION OF THE ORGANIZATION

CREDO ACTION is a nonprofit and apolitical association which priority is to promote rural women, children and young girls. Its mission is to help women and the young girls in rural areas quit poverty, to give them directions to defend their rights by building their capacities and creating conditions which ensure a better quality of life for them and their children and by extention for all the rural community. CREDO ACTION was created on April 16th, 1996 and was officially recognized by the Togolese State under the N °1012/MIS-SG-DAPSC-DSC, published in the official Government Publication N°1012/MIS-SG-DAPSC-DSC of September 11th, 1998.

**Our Vision** : «To promote women and children for a sustainable development»

**Our Strategic Orientations:** To support and follow up populations at the grassroots level particulary women to:

- increase the agricultural productivity;
- increase the incomes of the agricultural produces;

- Get access to loans
- undertake income-generating activities;
- manage health, education, training and human right problems ;
- provide for the children's needs and the one of their communities ;
- take in charge the orphan young girl.

**Our Areas of intervention** : agriculture, health, education/training, food safety and nutrition, Income-Generating Activities, children protection and rights, water and cleansing.

**Target Groups**: Rural women, orphan young girls, groups, cooperatives and communities at the grassroots level .

**Our Approach of Intervention**: It is based on the follow-up of organisational dynamics at the grassroots level . The main approach of intervention of CREDO ACTION follows a logic of research action-training. It is also participative in so far as the points of view of the recipients, the respect and equity between the social categories in their exchanges are constantly taken into account in decision makings.

**Zones of Intervention**: CREDO ACTION intervenes in the Maritime region in particular in the district of Vo, Zio, Lakes, Ave, Gulf and Commune of Lome. It has planned nevertheless to extend its activities to cover all areas of Togo in the short and medium term.

**Our Collaborations** : We are affiliated to national and international organizations that share the same visions and objectives as CREDO ACTION. These are : Network of the Womens' organizations of Francophone African counties (ROFAF); Women in Law and Development in Africa (WILDAF-Togo); Network of the Organizations for Right, Education, Health, Environment and Economy (RODESEE); Advisory and Economic Counsel (ECOSOC).

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### **Foreword of the President of the Board of Directors of CREDO ACTION**

CREDO ACTION is engaged in the activities of dynamization of community life with the ambition to make this association one of best that militates in favor of vulnerable people. These activities are carried out through the capacities building of the new members in the community life in order to adapt themselves to the values and methods of interventions of the Association.

The most important activity was the organization of the General Assembly of December 28<sup>th</sup>, 2014 with the renewal of the members of the leadership bodies. Within this framework, we can notice the renewal of the members of the Board of Directors ; also, the president changed position to become the Executive Director (ED).

It is important to point out that some new members decided to take from their monthly income, a significant sum of money to support the care taking of the orphan girls of the Children’s Charity Home of Sainte Thérèse d’Agbata.

Our adhesion to other organizations with the same objectives has also been profitable for our association during this year. For this purpose, the Executive Director legitimately represented the Network of the Organizations for the Right, Education, Health, Environment and Economy in the International Seminar on the Women's Right: Equality Homme /Woman. Fight against the violences against women in Paris, France, held from June 23<sup>rd</sup> to June 29<sup>th</sup>, 2014.

## INTRODUCTION

The year 2014 is a project implementation year that truly impacted the beneficiaries. The main mission of CREDO ACTION is to help women and young girls come out of poverty in rural areas, support them in the defense of their rights by building their capacities and creating an environment that gives them a better quality of life to their children and by extension to the whole rural community.

The major actions and the Annual Work Plan (AWP) 2014 result from the three-year action plan. As part of this management context by Axis / project CREDO Action performed during this year, four (04) projects linked to three areas of intervention which are agriculture and food security; health and education-Training.

During this year, the structure has recorded the end of the project Support to rural women in the marketing of agricultural produces and the evaluation mission the members of NEPAD /



Spain Fund from South Africa.

Despite the difficult context of funding and of personnel in the execution of the projects, the activities of the year 2014 were carried out up to 80%.

The Association held its Annual General Meeting in the last week of December. This meeting was an occasion to review the progress made and to ensure the visibility of the actions and approaches of CREDO ACTION towards its partners.

We have a partnership relation with ATD Quart Monde for a reading project implementation called "street library". The activities carried out during this year are significant and one of them goes over to the year 2015 the topics of which is related to the reproductive health.

In perspective, CREDO ACTION will implement the new partnership of research and funding techniques for a greater care needs of our targets

**PROJECTS CARRIED OUT IN 2014**  
**I. AREA OF AGRICULTURE AND FOOD SAFETY**

The activities of this area of intervention aim at contributing to strengthening food safety by significantly improving productivity and agricultural produces marketing. The aim is to create on one hand the conditions for better production and on the other, a real mastery of agricultural produces marketing channels together with an optimum use of management and financial-accounting tools.

**The strategy applied:** this is to strengthen of farmers' organizations and build the capacities of their members on various plans and topics such as: organizational, institutional; financial; technical and communicative; trading and dialogue. It is based on the development of a genuine partnership with Microfinance Institutions (MFIs), some public institutions such ICAT. It is based on a context of empowerment and self-promotion of the beneficiaries.

**The target:** groups and cooperatives. In total 1050 people

### **Projects carried out in 2014**

Two projects (2) were implemented in 2014: Assistance to rural women in the marketing of agricultural produces in the districts of Avé, Vo and Zio (last stage) and the Training project in better techniques of transformation of cassava (gari, atchèkè, etc) and in notion of basic accounting. Management of income-generating activities in the district of Zio.

#### **Project 01:**

**Support for rural women in the marketing of agricultural produces in the districts of Avé, Vo and Zio (last stage)**

**Starting year of the project:** 2012

**Financial Partner:** NEPAD /Spain Funds

**Beneficiaries:** members of associations and cooperatives around 750 people including 650 women

**Zone of intervention:** District of Avé (Ando Gbéroukondji, Ando Avédzié, Ando Gboloba, District of Zio (Kpomé Agomé, District of Vo (Vo Koutimé and Vo Kponou)

**Objective of the year:** To train the members of the beneficiary organizations on the organization and the good management of an income-generating activity; To put at the disposal of women association the working capital to make their activities profitable

#### **Activities carried out:**

The activities carried out are an obvious result of those started the previous years but with a particular emphasis on the follow-up.

- ❖ Capacity building of the members of the association in management of income-generating activity (AGR)

- ❖ Continuation of the process of mutation of the associations into simplified cooperative societies (SCOOPS)
- ❖ Construction of three shops in the villages of Ando Gbémoukondji, Kpomé Agomé and Vo koutimé
- ❖ Financial support for the associations in the purchase of the agricultural produces and marketing.

### **Results obtained during the year**

- ❖ All the sessions of the trainings were held in each locality of the project
- ❖ The associations have necessary knowledge that can lead them to manage their activity
- ❖ All the negotiations were made for the registration but due to some problems on the field, the competent authorities had suspended the delivery of serial number until further notice.
- ❖ The food stores are actually built in the villages of Ando Gbémoukondji, Kpomé Agomé and Vo koutimé
- ❖ The associations were given working capital which was used for the purchase of the agricultural produces



## **Appreciations and prospects**

Even if the sale of the produces is not yet effective in all the localities due to the sale price which has fallen on the local markets, the organizations still hope for a better future of the activities. They have expressed a real interest in working capital and intend to work for the success of the marketing which depends on the complementary actions such as conservation, good storage, the establishment of a alarm network of the prices on the various local markets.

## **Project 02**

**Training project in better techniques of transformation of cassava (gari, atchèkè, etc) and in notion of basic accounting. Management of income-generating activities in the district of Zio.**

**Execution year:** 2014

**Financial Partner:** National Fund for Apprenticeship, Training and Professional Improvement (NFATPI)

**Beneficiaries:** 50 members of NEVAME association of Kpomé Agomé

**Zone of intervention:** The project covers the township of Kpomé and in the district of Zio.

**Objective of the year:** to train the women of the association on the better techniques of the transformation of cassava (gari, atchèkè, etc) and on the simplified accounting for a greater productivity and competitiveness of their agricultural produces.

Activities carried out:

- ❖ Training on the management of income generating activity notably simplified accounting, bookkeeping and the exploitation account
- ❖ modern techniques of production of gari, atiéké
- ❖ packaging techniques of gari
- ❖ maintenance of the rasper and the presser
- ❖ regular follow-ups carried out directly in the association

### **Results obtained during the year**

- ❖ 50 members of which 45 women followed the training on....
- ❖ Increase in the work productivity thanks to the use of a rasper, presser and packaging machine.
- ❖ Change in community life of the members of the Névamé association.

### **Result and Appreciation**

The implementation of these activities contributed to the capacity building of 50 people including 45 women. They had the support of CREDO ACTION in the technical, organisational and management plans. The equipment of the association contributed to the increase in the work productivity.

A documentary film and a photograph gallery have capitalized the assets of this project



## II. AREA OF HEALTH

This field constitutes one of the components of the 2014 annual work plan. It aims at especially reinforcing the health status of the population in rural areas. A bad health status of the population blocks the implementation of the development actions. Thus we must act even though on the national plan, important progress have been made.

In the rural areas, some women continue to practise some behaviours that do not march with the principles of the modern medicine, and this exposes their own life and the one of the new borns to danger. In these areas, the practices of hygiene are non-existent and those of the primary care are almost absent.

### **Objective of the year:**

Facilitating the access of the populations mainly the rural populations to health care for the improvement of their living conditions and work.

**Target community:** The actions are being implemented for the benefit of the population especially women, young girls and the children

**Strategy:** To lead the population to become aware of their health status and the risks incurred in matter of health concerning some practices in rural areas.

## **Project 01**

### **Maternal health for all in rural areas in the village of Ando Avédji**

**Execution year:** 2014

**Financial Partner:** Fiduciary Funds for the second decade of native people in the world – UN

**Beneficiaries:** 350 persons (pregnant women, wet nurses and young girls)

**Zone of intervention:** village of Ando Avédji in the district of Avé

#### **Objectie of the year:**

- Improve maternal health of pregnant women and young girls the village of Ando Avédji
- Allow the pregnant women to have access to the prenatal cares
- Insure the elementary health care and hygiene for women and new borns
- Prevent young girls from the risks and nondesired pregnancies
- Sensitize and train the women on the family planning in order to ensure a maternal good health to them.

#### **Activities carried out:**

- Awareness of the rural community on the importance of the prenatal consultations
- Awareness of the rural community against discrimination and marginalisation of women and the young girl
- Awareness of the rural community against dangerous cultural practices against maternal and infantile health
- Follow-up and regular check up of pregnant women of Ando Avédji during the period of the project by a qualified health agent
- Training of the pregnant women and the young girls of Ando Avédji on family planning and good practices of hygienes during the pregnancy and after the delivery by a qualified health agent
- Training of young girls on the prevention of risk pregnancies (practices of contraception) by a qualified health agent.

#### **Results obtained:**

- 75 pregnant women were recorded by the project 85% of which have already given birth;
- 55 young girls were concerned by the project;
- 20 sessions of awareness and training were organized for beneficiaries;
- 48 follow-ups and regular controls have been carried out by the community health agents;
- 70% women and young girls concerned by the project practised contraceptive measures of family planning;
- 75% of women and young girls attended almost all the sessions of awareness and trainings and have decided to change their behaviors;

- A team made up of two qualified Community health agents, two social agents of development and a psychologist was set up and followed all the activities of the project;
- A local management committee made up of resource persons and members of CVD is set up and supervises the activities of the project.



**Prospects:**

Under the supervision of a local management committee, the recipients have set up a club of mothers which will meet from time to time to exchange on the acquired knowledge and the teachings of the project. CREDO ACTION Association often intervenes in the area and it will mobilize its social development agents and the recruited Community health agents who work in the area to organise quarterly exchange meetings with the beneficiaries of the project. This initiative will make it possible for the beneficiaries to perpetuate the experience they have acquired from the project.



### III. AREA OF EDUCATION & TRAINING

The analysis of the education system as regards supervision of early childhood and pre-school education, shows that the cover rate still remains very weak and suffers from a lack of equipments for care taking of early childhood, this led to the development, especially on the level of the rural communities, of Nursery schools of Local Initiative and the makeshift School of Local Initiative, entirely under the charge of poor parents.

Even if Togolese government obtained a decennial plan of development of the education sector (Sectoral Plan of Education-SPE) covering the period of 2010-2020, the situation of the children who need education remains a serious issue. This education – training line aims at reinforcing the education of the children of any kind and effective care taking of the needy girls and orphans in an orphanage for their true self-fulfilment .

An educational project “Street Library” is initiated in partnership with ATD Quart Monde (France).

#### Project 01 : « Street Library Project »

**Execution year:** 2014

**Financial Partner:** ATD Quart Monde

**Beneficiaries:** 250 persons (children, young, adults attending school or not attending school)

**Zone of intervention:** Commune of Lomé

**Summary of the project:** The Association has signed a partnership with ATD Quart Monde of Beauvais in France within the framework of a project called “Street Library”. It is an activity of reading of books open to all the public especially the young people and the children in a green space. Nearly 150 people come of knowledge resource, to familiarize themselves with and improve their knowledge each Sunday after midday at 2 p.m.

#### **Objectives of the project:**

- ↳ Allow children, young people and the adults attending school or not who do not have access to the classical library to be in contact with the books;
- ↳ To reduce the incapacity of the children (attending school or not) to read, write and speak French;
- ↳ To allow the population to familiarize itself with the books for their sociocultural development.

#### **Activities carried out:**

Animations of book reading meetings and various games by supervisors/monitors every Sunday in a district of Lomé



### **Results obtained:**

The children, the young people and the adults blossom through their participation in the activities of the reading club of their various districts. They learn a better integration in the society.

Within the framework of providing for needs of pupils who take part in the activities of the project, and CREDO-ACTION offered them school kits in prelude of the resuming of the academic year 2014-2015.

A celebration of end of the year was also organized for these children. The activities took place respectively at the beach and the inn of KPESSI. More than 200 children participated in this celebration.

### **ACTIVITIES OF THE ORPHANAGE CHILDREN'S HOME OF SAINTE THÉRÈSE D'AGBATA**

For the protection and the right of children, CREDO ACTION have created an orphanage. In this centre, sixteen (16) girls are financially and materially taken in charge within the framework of the continuation of their school education. They are aged between six (06) and fourteen (14) years and are shared up between the class of primary 2 and fourth grade.

Besides the school education, these girls of the orphanage follow practical trainings in income-generating activities such as manufacturing of local soap, liquid soap, coconut vegetable oil, kitchen garden, the baltic, etc

To end the year in good conditions, the girls of the orphanage took part in the celebration activities of end year together with the children of the street Library project.

Apart from the girls as interns, the association also supported twenty-five (25) other orphan girls who are placed in host families.

## II. CAPITALIZATIONS, CAPACITIES BUILDING AND ACTIVITIES IN NETWORK

The internal capacities building of the operational team was done through self-training, trainings, workshops and animation of internal reflection in the form of teaching days, in this effect, in 2014, there was:

An internal training workshop on the following sets of themes: The management of difficult behaviors within an organization; the management of reception centre; basic principles of social work; techniques of listening of cases and the material accounting: Equipment and inventory management.

Within the framework of its partnerships, the association took part in the discussion online organized by ONU-FEMME on the System of Knowledge in January 2014. This system permitted CREDO ACTION to present all its activities and its prospects of the year.

It took part in the reflection day organized by ROFAF within the framework of gender in the development program to be implemented after 2015 of the OMD held from September 4<sup>th</sup> to September 5<sup>th</sup>, 2014 in Lomé.

The association also took part in the training, information and sensitizing workshop organized by Association Women and Environment with the financial support of ROFAF. The topics discussed during this workshop were related to the resolutions “1325,1820,1888,1889” of the United Nations, Lome, April 2014.

In the framework of the activities of RODESEE, the Executive Director took part in the International Seminar on Women's right: Equality Men/ Woman. Fight against violences against women in Paris, France, held from June 23<sup>rd</sup> to June 29<sup>th</sup>, 2014.
